



is practical and feasible the near-filled container can be shipped complete from ZRMetal to LCFlake. Or, if NDRhythm decides such a line of logistics is too long and costly, this responsibility would be LCDrink's upon ZRMetal's advice.

d. The drop should be a scatter-pattern, even more scattered than JBAIert fragmentary A-P bombs. At appears that at this juncture, [ ] should be consulted in the matter of (1) parachutes (2) containers (3) a wide scatter-pattern and (4) methods of dispatching. The problem, then, of supplying the necessary dropping paraphernalia falls to [ ] or his supply section. BGFicnd LCDrink, then must be advised of ZRMetal/ [ ] instructions.

e. It seems reasonable to think in minimum terms of six or eight months' supplies, certainly to carry beyond the winter months. Approximately two tons (complete) can be delivered to LCBatland in one lift. The matter of gauging the schedule to monthly or bi-monthly drops would depend upon the success of the effort and the amount of coverage possible during each penetration. Also, should the scheme strike a particularly vulnerable target, enemy reaction may enter as a greater factor.

4. To insure a sustained program and to avoid any delays in its initiation, it is suggested that, based upon the above, a division of labor be made between ZRMetal and LCDrink, that respective parties be so notified, that, an officer be designated in ZRMetal to back-stop this project at least through its infancy, and that future correspondence utilize the cables.

5. In conclusion it is understood by this facility that [ ] and [ ] believed one test drop should be made before a full program was launched. In order to stage such a test, such that was noted in paragraph 3 above will have to be accomplished first. A cable directive would be appreciated.
