The attention of [ ] was called to the fact that contrary to the information given to the [ ] by Ambassador Peurifoy to the effect that retention of the British Police Mission would not be recommended by the United States ~~XXXXXXXXXX~~ Embassy. A cable to the State Department by the Ambassador stated that retention of the mission for one year would be recommended. This discrepancy was also called to the attention of FDP/OSO which has shown great interest in the future of the British Police Mission in Greece.
