**MEMORANDUM FOR: CHIEF, EE-I**

**SUBJECT: EE-I DAILY PROGRESS REPORT, THURSDAY, 29 NOVEMBER 1951**

1. BGFIEND. A reception was held at the Hotel Warwick in New York City by the National Committee for a Free Albania on Independence Day, 28 November 1951. The Committee dispatched telegrams to Anthony Eden and Dean Acheson noting the occasion and extending greetings. The State Department sent a reply to the Committee signed by Under Secretary James E. Webb. The text of this reply was released to the press and mention of the event appeared in the NEW YORK TIMES and NEW YORK HERALD TRIBUNE on 29 November. Press clippings are attached.
