Although your note of November 29th summarizing your views regarding the location of the official seat of HTEIGH is appreciated, I fear that it and the exchange of telegrams in connection with the TPCREDO Independence Day celebration have revealed a divergence of opinion over the location of this headquarters.

To refresh your memory and explain my position I should like to point out that one of the specific points of agreement at the meetings held in BOHIDY between the 16th and the 25th of June, 1949 concerned the establishment of the HTEIGH Committee headquarters in BCTOWN.⁴ Subsequent to this agreement, Identity (1) passed a memorandum to [redacted] in 4 August 1949 which said in part: "Following is text of the proposed announcement agreed with [redacted] and HTEIGH in TPCREDO-6 and approved in BOHIDY: HTEIGH is hereby created to represent all those KWAAHOS who wish to establish a representative government and fundamental human liberties in their own country. HTEIGH includes representatives of the principal KWAAHOS in the social and political sphere and will have its principal seat in BCTOWN." Because these and other documents that have passed between our services confirm the above understanding, and because I have no record or recollection of any amendment to this agreement, your letter came as somewhat of a surprise to me.

I feel that moving the HTEIGH headquarters to any city other than BCTOWN would be inconsistent with the pattern already established for the financial support under QIVORY. Such procedure would lead to complications, serve no particular purpose and would not be acceptable to us.

If necessary, we shall be able to discuss this matter further during my next trip abroad which I plan before long. Looking forward to seeing you, and with warm regards.
