1. Tentative plans are being made for the establishment of a station frontier interrogation center somewhere in northern LCFlake. BGFriend proposes to assign a representative to such an office and requests that ZRMetal be on the lookout for someone suitable to fill the position. If possible, we should prefer a KMWahoo/PBPrime with fluent knowledge of LCFlake, DTEthyl or HBFairy. As the living conditions in conjunction with such a job will undoubtedly be far below HTCurio standards it is thought that a single person would be most suitable. We would appreciate receiving full background information on any likely candidates before headquarters makes any definite commitments to them.
