1. Subjects, Identities (1) and (2), as [] will remember were chosen as members of the Military Junta several years ago and advised by [] that they would be transferred to Rome in the near future. In the meantime they were given a subsistence of a 1,000,000 drs. (then \$66., now \$33) per month until such time as they were to be transferred to Rome. For some time now subjects have petitioned [] through members of the HIGRUBBY staff to get them assigned to active duty or at least raise their subsistence which they claim is insufficient to meet their needs and which is much lower than that paid to other supporters of the N.C.F.A. in Rome with comparable positions.

2. In order to maintain some standard of compensation, BGFIEND [] requests information from [] concerning the sum at which other comparable N.C.F.A. workers are being retained, as well as [] recommendation for any increase in subjects' retainer compensation.
