SUBJECT: Conversation with MI-6 Regarding Albanian Matters

REFERENCE: Memorandum for the Record, same subject, dated
24 August 1953

1. [] MI-6, called on 31 August to report that he had ascertained that his Headquarters had no intention of transferring [] from his present post as VALUABLE representative, Rome, and intended to keep him there indefinitely.

2. [] also said he had been advised by his Headquarters that the British would be happy to discuss Yugoslavia or "any other subject" during the course of a proposed forthcoming FIEND-VALUABLE meeting in London.

3. I expressed our gratification at both of these items.
