Organization of Albanians in Europe by The British

Reference: STIA-2841, 2 September 1953

1. Reference report was most interesting [redacted] and undoubtedly to all addresses. Through the past few years there have been several unconfirmed reports of possible British cooperation with the Yugoslavs on Albania but no reports to our knowledge of the British creating a new committee particularly one that would omit from membership the Balli Kombetar which has so long been a favorite with the British. Therefore, because of the unusual twist to this report, any further information would be of interest and significance.

2. BGFIND [redacted] has been most pleased with the work that is currently being done on Albanian affairs [redacted] in the near future we plan to follow up previous correspondence and [redacted] and [redacted] visits by sending you a paper outlining what particular help we need and what we would like to have you provide if at all possible. Your continued cooperation is appreciated.
