MEMORANDUM FOR: CHIEF, POLITICAL AND PSYCHOLOGICAL WARFARE

SUBJECT : Daily Log

BOFIEND

[ ] reports that on 26 September the residence of former King Zog was seized by Egyptian Army and police units under orders from the Ministry of the Interior and a three-hour search conducted of the premises. Certain financial and other papers were seized, and a guard detail was left at the residence. Zog yielded under protest to superior force, apparently after obtaining acceptance of his condition that his personal files on Albania be spared. [ ] contact with Zog expressed his belief that the purpose of the raid was to uncover evidence of black market dealings and political activity with anti-Naguib elements which would permit action by the military tribunal to expel Zog and his entourage from Egypt without money or property.
