VALUABLE Request for DZ' coordinates

Account of Developments

20 April

1. HTGRUBBY scripts (1-15 April) passed; VALUABLE informed of Tirana trial leaflet raid.

28 April

2. VALUABLE advises their April leaflet raid indefinitely postponed due engine trouble their aircraft. Sample April OBKEEK passed. [] told several reports from our team leaders are reaching this desk indicating GUATLEBAUM continuing activities which we believe to be damaging our interests.

30 April

3. VALUABLE requests information we may have available on DZ's in the Kukes zone. [] raises the question of movement of AIQUAD and AILAKE to Austria again. The writer repeated previous statements that due to operational developments we would prefer to hold this pair in Greece for the time being. [] agreed to arrange for transportation if and when need for these people in Greece ends. To avoid any feeling on

VALUABLE's part that the local HTNEIGH office was exclusively an OBOPUS concern the writer reviewed the local situation with RNPOSTAL advising him of AIKERF'S role and opened the door for any possible contacts.

3 May

4. Information on DZ's known to OBOPUS in Northeastern Albania passed. [] requests OBOPUS follow up on a transfer payment for Koce Dule that OBOPUS made at VALUABLE's request in October 1953.

7 May

5. HTRUBBY scripts (15-30 April) passed together with text May OBKEEK. This was returned with his comments on 10 May. At this meeting [] stated London hoped for close co-operation on PT material at this Station as was the case in Rome. RNPOSTAL raised several new questions at London's request on the new Pasaporte which they were most interested in according to RNPOSTAL. RNJUMPIT's departure from Rome was confirmed and [] stated he was depressed by difficulties in the Legatitet movement.

13 May

6. [] of KUBARK [] present for meeting. Word of OBOPUS leaflet raid of May 12/13 passed. Memo answering VALUABLE questions on Pasaporte was handed to []. [] advises he is continuing his efforts to obtain subscriptions to Albanian newspapers. [] inquired why Shaska had not appeared in Lavrion as yet and was informed this Albanian was being held for interrogation.

Writer's Comment:

7. During the review period no developments of significance in the Athens liaison relationship occurred. It is obvious discussions on HTNEIGH and the new arrangement in Rome are painful and are not pursued.
