## Status Report On Agent Standbys

1. We currently have seven OBOPUS agents in addition to CASH, who is the subject of another report, that we are sustaining on standby status. We are listing these below with comment on each for your information and files:

## 2. Standby agents:

a. AIRPUMP - W/T tentatively scheduled to accompany WEDNESDAY team. He is now living in "The Lodge," our new Kiffissia safehouse, with AIRWAY and AIRBLOWN. He is reported to be in good health and spirits by   who is maintaining contact with him.

b. AIRBLOWN - W/T tentatively scheduled for the TUESDAY mission, should it prove feasible. He is reported to be in good health and spirits by

c. AIRWAY - W/T tentatively scheduled as follow up for WEDNESDAY mission should first phase be successful. He is reported in good health and spirits by

In the middle of May the three W/T standbys discontinued the English lessons they were taking in Athens. They completed the primary course and their understanding of Greek (classes conducted in Greek) is not good enough to take more advanced instructions. Since the 13th of May these men have been monitoring Albanian broadcasts for

d. AIRWISE - tentatively scheduled for TUESDAY mission. He is living in Meridi with his father and AIRBORNE. He is reported to be in good health and spirits by [ ] who contacts him twice a week.

e. AIRBORNE - tentatively scheduled for TUESDAY mission. He is reported by [ ] to be in good health and spirits.

f. ENORDAIN - tentatively scheduled to lead WEDNESDAY mission. He is still intent on reestablishing his old team of AIRSLACK, AIRWORTHY and RONDRELOY. The latter two are now in Lavrica, and we have no intention of using them again. Failing this possibility, ENORDAIN requested on 20 May that we speed their re-settlement. He was assured that everything possible was being done. He is very eager to go to work and is in good health and spirits. He is contacted twice a week.

g. AIRSLACK - tentatively scheduled for WEDNESDAY mission. He is living in a hotel in Athens with ENORDAIN. He is also in good health and spirits.

3. We will continue this practice of reporting all unassigned agents as a group unless you instruct us to the contrary.
