11. Summary

Mission and Plan

To further the FP mission against Albania by means of clandestine radio broadcasts of a propaganda nature.

Summary

1. The clandestine radio maintained its regular schedule of four daily transmissions with several repetitions after each scheduled program. The programs during August stressed Enver Hoxha's replacement by Mehmet Shehu as Prime Minister; the visit to Berlin of Vera Pojani, one of the ranking women Communists in Albania; an appeal to Albanian women in connection with the mobilization of girls for work on the Enver Hydrocentral plant; the true meaning of the decision to lower some of the taxation on peasants; and an answer to Radio Tirana's claims concerning the health conditions in Albania.

2. An Albanian army lieutenant who recently sought refuge in Greece reported that he was able to receive the radio broadcasts rather well in the Korca area. He stated further that other army officers had told him of having heard the broadcasts in widely scattered parts of Albania.

3. A monitoring report from Ioannina covering the period 22 June to 29 June states that 16 of the 18 transmissions monitored were excellent in reception; the other two were clearly intelligible approximately 60% of the time.

4. Arrangements were made in Frankfurt to have 35 letters containing recent issues of the Shqiperia digest mailed to Albanian officials in various satellite countries from the East Zone of Germany.
