Headquarters' Action Required

- a. Does Headquarters wish VALUABLE called on Wadborg political activity?
- b. Decision on suggestion in final paragraph regarding article drops.

Summary

- a. [ ] in Austria and England.
- b. VALUABLE advises OBOPUS of Sujli arrival and [ ] interrogation in Austria.
- c. Wadborg, local VALUABLE indigenous employee, reportedly passing out news bulletins of new committee.

1. As reported in reference [ ], left Athens for an undisclosed destination before the middle of August. We understood this trip was to be followed by home leave and do not expect him back before October. In the meantime the writer will deal with (Identity 1) whenever necessary.

2. On 27 August (Identity 1) met with [ ] and gave the writer a verbal report on the arrival in Austria of Galip Sujli, a former Albanian Army officer, and his interrogation by [ ], which was the subject of [ ] 8056 and subsequent correspondence. This explained [ ]'s whereabouts and gave us first notice of what should be an interesting interrogation project. At this meeting [ ] passed (Identity 1) a routine memo on our overflight of 23 August with copies of the OBKEEK dropped, HTGRUBBY scripts, and some intelligence on the Konispol area.

3. [ ] also filled in (Identity 1) to the extent possible on the political development concerning the formation of the new committee. (Identity 1) knew nothing of this whatsoever and expressed regret over this further split in the emigration. It was stated Wadborg would naturally not have anything to do with this group as his terms of employment precluded political activity. Hence

8. No other meetings took place during the report period.

9. In checking some back VALUABLE correspondence the Athens Albanian desk finds OTEA 1206, 17 March 1958, and raises the following point. If VALUABLE still has the article stocks reported in this dispatch, and if it is correct their overflights are suspended or eliminated would VALUABLE give us this material (packaged safety pins and soap) for dropping? Pick up could be arranged by [ ] to coincide with a flight to England by an Athens Station aircraft. It will be remembered VALUABLE raised this possibility at the October 1958 London meeting. (Please see para 14 of the minutes of the meeting OTEA 1217, 13 November 1958). [ ] raises this hoping to build up our dropping stocks of PW material.
