Headquarters' Action Required:

Synopsis:

- a. The presence of FRIDAY in Patras became known to the Albanian community in Athens.
- b. FRIDAY was moved to Kalamaj.

Account of Developments:

1. October 29: In a casual conversation with [ ] at the Annapolis house, AIRWISE asked how RNDOLLAR was getting along in Patras. Nothing more was said on this subject at the time.
2. November 1: [ ] and [ ] went to the Annapolis house to see SATURDAY and [ ] questioned AIRWISE on his knowledge of RNDOLLAR's whereabouts. AIRWISE explained that the father of AIRBRAKE's fiancee lives in Patras and AIRBRED had recently called on him there. He then wrote to the AIRWISE family about the meeting.
3. November 6: In accordance with our request to [ ] two days previously, RNDOLLAR and AIRBRED reported in Athens with all their gear and were removed to the Annapolis safehouse.
4. November 8: RNDOLLAR and AIRBRED were asked to explain their security breach to [ ] and [ ]. It seems that AIRBREAK's fiancee herself had identified AIRBRED in the street one day and had waved and called to him. AIRBRED claims to have ignored her and gotten away as quickly as possible. This story was accepted as we had no proof to the contrary. RNDOLLAR and AIRBRED were told that it would be impossible for them to return to Patras for obvious security reasons and that arrangements would be made for them to go to another town as soon as possible.

5. November 10: In accordance with [ ]'s arrangements with [ ] FRIDAY reported to [ ] office for removal to the town of Kalamai in the Southern Peloponnesus. The boys were told that they would be brought up again for staging toward the middle of December.

6. Our target date for the third mounting of FRIDAY is 20 December. We will not have the full benefit of the dark of the moon until the 22nd, but it goes into its last quarter on the 16th and will not rise until shortly after 0400 on the morning of 21 December, so we do not anticipate any difficulty on this score.
