October 3:

1. BODOLAR and AIRBORNE reported to the BIR safehouse by previous arrangements made when BODOLAR telephoned this office on the sterile telephone. They were briefed on the training they would undergo in the coming week. Both men were instructed as to where and when they would be met for each phase of training. AIRBORNE was not given any more details than had previously been told to him on 26 September. (Para 4 of reference.) The men were also passed their pay for September.

October 4:

2. C J met BODOLAR and AIRBORNE and outfitted both men in suitable clothes and boots for hiking. The men were taken on a three hour night march in the hills outside of Athens.

October 5:

3. C J picked up the team at night and they were again taken for a three hour night march. During the march the techniques of direction finding at night were reviewed. The men were told that arrangements had been made for weapons firing on the following day.

October 6:

4. Cable is received from Headquarters recommending operation be cancelled. BODOLAR and AIRBORNE were contacted and advised arrangements for this day were cancelled. The men were instructed to report to the BIR on 6 October.

October 6:

5. C J and C J met BODOLAR and AIRBORNE at the BIR. The men were told it had been decided to cancel the mission. AIRBORNE explained it was

He requested [] do whatever possible to reverse this decision by convincing the proper authority of the validity of the mission. [] had proposed.

6. REDOLLAR has been contacted regularly all this month and was met by ANSON on 29 October when he was given his and AIRBORNE's pay for October.
