## a. Action reported by Field:

1. The NCFA newspaper Shqipëria was published on schedule during the month of February.
2. The NCFA 3-man delegation which visited Munich during this period to meet with U.S. Consular and Military authorities in that city returned to Rome. This delegation visited Munich to discuss the ouster of certain Albanians from the Labor Service Company and to request the dismissal of Captain Caush BASHO as CO of that unit. In spite of strong protests which the delegation made to the military authorities the latter maintained their stand in support of Captain BASHO.
3. The NCFA in Rome has undertaken to strongly combat the Tirana Repatriation Program through the medium of the newspaper Shqipëria and intensified propaganda in correspondence among Albanian circles.

## b. Action Reported by Headquarters:

1. During this period Hasan DOSTI of NCFA received a letter from the Civil Affairs Section of the Pentagon informing him that the situation in the 4000th Labor Service Company in Munich had been investigated by the authorities there. Further, it had been concluded that Political activities within that Unit, which would adversely affect the U.S. military mission, would have to be eliminated. This letter indicated that the issue i.e. dismissal of certain NCFA elements from the 4000th Labor Service Company, is now closed.
2. On 15 February [ ] of the Albanian Branch met with Halim BEGEJA, NCFA member of the New York office to discuss matters pertaining to the Committee and Albanian refugees. The following topics were discussed during this meeting: The Tirana Amnesty Decree; The SHEHU--HOXHA attendance at the Communist Party Congress in Moscow; NCFA Delegation to the ACEN meeting in Strasbourg; the anti-DOSTI article in the newspaper Kombi-Shqiptar; and, the NCFA Delegation's recent visit to Munich
3. Mr. DOSTI was appointed Chairman of the Committee and Councils in Exile organization for a period of three months.

Discussions between SE, IO and the Department of State concerning the establishment of a new Albanian Committee and termination of SE support to NCFA.

**d. Security Factors:**

On 27 February Mr. DOSTI met with FRANCESKO a confirmed UDB Agent in the N.Y. office of NCFA. FRANCESKO, the same individual who had previously contacted DOSTI in November of 1954 had requested this recent meeting. According to DOSTI FRANCESKO queried him for about 30 minutes on NCFA affairs, AGEN matters and King ZOG's political activities. Finally at FRANCESKO's request the two departed from DOSTI's office to visit a restaurant. However, DOSTI, who felt that this was an alibi to have him photographed or pointed out to an accomplice, terminated the meeting on the pretext that he had to keep another appointment. FRANCESKO requested another meeting which, however failed to materialize. The FBI has been apprised of the foregoing

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
