SPECIFIC— Status Report on Agent Stand-bys for Period 1 - 31 January 1956

REFERENCE: SGAA-19208 dated 23 January 1956

Action Requested: None; for Headquarters information and files.

1. There are eight OBHUNT agent stand-bys.

2. AIRWISE has been contacted at regular intervals during this entire period. He has fully recovered from his operation and is in good health. During a meeting at the DIG, AIRWISE told [] he has decided to postpone his marriage until later this year. He stated he would be very pleased if he were able to participate in one more mission for the organization.

3. AICCOOL continues to attend the Benchitters Course in Piraeus. [] Persistent reports have been reaching us indicating AICCOOL finds it impossible to refrain from becoming involved with the various political factions existing among the Albanians in Athens, in spite of our constant instructions to the contrary. AICCOOL, seeking to become a member of the Legalitet, was rejected and has since been making AIPOET a target for his animosity. HBHADDOCK has charged AIPOET with making unfavorable remarks about Greece based on a report by an undisclosed informant. Our preliminary investigation indicates the story may have been fabricated by AICCOOL and/or the Agrarians.

4. On 31 January, [] met AICCOOL at the DIG to pay him. [] informed AICCOOL we could no longer tolerate his involvements and actions as they were contrary to the objectives of our organization. He was advised that his displays of immature judgment had destroyed our confidence in him. He would either refrain from any further entanglements or suffer immediate dismissal.

5. AIRBLOWN continues to share his quarters in Piraeus with AICCOOL. [] had several meetings with AIRBLOWN concerning his misgivings about AICCOOL as reported in reference. AIRBLOWN has proven to be a very reluctant informant. He avoided reporting any of the incidents reported to us by others and indicated he thought AICCOOL was merely young and easily influenced rather than what he actually had reported originally.

6. ALLICH and AIRPUMP continue to reside in Khalkis. The men are taking English lessons which we are financing as a measure to keep them occupied. ALLICH was given permission to come to Athens on 17 January for two days to visit his father who is ill. Both men reported to Athens again on 31 January to pick up their pay.

7. AIRBORNE has been sharing quarters with RNDOLLAR in a house located in the outskirts of Athens. Contact is maintained with him through RNDOLLAR. He is good health and continues his quiet, trouble-free existence.

8. RNORDAIN returned to Navplion on 4 January and AIRSLACK remained in Athens for further processing for emigration. He also returned to Navplion on 18 January to rejoin RNORDAIN. Both men were contacted again on 31 January when they were paid.
