1. There are six OBHUNT standby agents.
 2. RNDOLLAR has fully recovered from his operation although further treatment was required to assist the healing of his incision. The expenses for his operation were paid by U.S.E.P. who are processing RNDOLLAR'S emigration.

3. AIRWISE has requested we assist in speeding up his resettlement. We have therefore asked U.S.E.P. to remove the "hold" classification on his processing and to expedite his emigration. AIRWISE was met regularly this last month by [] and []

4. AILICH continues to live in Pireaus where he shares quarters with AIRBLOWN. In view of his imminent departure for the United States, AILICH has requested permission to marry. We advised him we had no objections but he should first determine what effect his marriage would have on his emigration and if his future wife would be able to accompany him.

5. RNDORDAIN and AIRBORNE continue to live in Agaleo. During this month both men, as were all the standby agents, were given some summer clothing as provided by our agreement. The men are contacted at regular intervals and were last met on 30 June.

6. AIRBLOWN continues to attend the advanced Benchfitters' School in Pireaus, where he is living with AILICH. He is met regularly by [] and is successful in remaining aloof from the intrigues and politics prevalent among most Albanians.

7. AICOOL once more has been the subject of numerous reports and complaints. In spite of the warning given to AICOOL in January, as reported in second reference, he has renewed his attacks on various members of this organization and the organization itself. When [] confronted AICOOL with the reports of his actions and involvements, AICOOL made no effort to deny them. He was informed he would be terminated, as we had warned him previously. Arrangements have been made for AICOOL to be quartered at the Benchfitters' School.
