Dear Halim

It is some time since we have corresponded. It seems that now you are a member of the NCPA you have started to forget us.

Attached to this letter, I am sending you a report which I wish to submit to the American Mission in Munich. As soon as you get this report, please work on it and translate it for me into English. Send it to me in five copies.

I do hope that you will regard with a favorable eye what I have prepared and that you are able to take care of it, since it is in your line. I wish to say, you can add to it and you can strike out parts. Then after you have finished it, send me five copies in English and one copy in Albanian. I hope that within ten days from today's date, the reports will be in my hand. The matter seems urgent to me and therefore I urge you, as soon as you get this letter, get at it and return it in two days.

Up to now, here we are, we have had hopes of the NCPA's making some change—it seems however that you of the committee just have a name, not an actuality, and up to now you haven't done anything at all. At all events, we are glad to be in good health (?)

As I write you, we have no news here, except Caush's villainies. There is no use my going into it for 'the cream has gone, and the taste has gone with it'. To tell the truth, we thought of you more than the other members of the committee, since you are somewhat more active than the others and you know Basho better. Everything should be done at the proper time. Perhaps you can't do anything either. We believe that everyone has his own problems (?)

I haven't any further news. I beg you again, don't hold up this which I am sending you. So do your best and make it better than I have done by putting in anything else you may know. I am only too glad to receive help. Mr. Myrteza Veshi wrote me once and I answered. It seems that he accidentally burned his hand. I expressed good wishes and wished him a Happy New Year.

Now, dear Halim, on the occasion of the New Year, I wish that God, who arranges everything, grant you many years in our dear Albania.
