1. It will interest [] to know that not one single word of Apple Team's activity has reached [] from the usually reliable "KWAAHCO mental telepathy and coffee-house gossip society". This is a major achievement and [] would like to extend his congratulations.

2. FYI, Red Team send word to the Military Junta that they are inside but they don't say where. The Junta sent them \$200.00 and a camera with the request that the bill numbers, camera number and one exposed but undeveloped film be sent out to prove authenticity and security of the letter drop.

3. A test has been made by [] in which an attempt was made to mail a film cassette through KMULCER open mails to HTCURIO. The attempt failed. Thus, if the Red Team mailing reaches the Junta's hands without having been tampered with and the film is not ruined believe it is then safe to assume the letter drop the Red Team and the Junta insist is secure may supply needed link with the team.

4. In such an event [] has assured the Junta that additional aid and materiel will be sent to the team. Meanwhile, [] has instructed the Junta to advise the Red leader that no correspondence is to be conducted by the team except through the letter drop and that any intelligence gathered is to be sent solely to the Junta.
