1. The following is the report of the Apple resupply staged on September 5-6. Leaflets were dropped for cover purposes only. The mission was aborted as no reception was found at the DZ site.

The total flight time was five hours and forty-five minutes, including fifty-three minutes over Albania.

2. The load consisted of 9 cartons of leaflets; 150,000 Symbol (550 lbs), 66,000 "Today and Tomorrow" (375 lbs), and 25,000 "Government of Thieves" (110 lbs) leaflets. Two cases were dropped at each of the first three D/Z's and three at Tirana. The resupply load consisted of four

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bundles containing items listed in attachment #3 and weighing 385 pounds. The four bundles were rigged to two parachutes to speed up the drop. However, the crew reported that on arrival at the DZ position, there were no reception lights visible. They flew three two minutes legs in different directions from the supposed DZ location and, seeing no further evidence of a reception, completed the flight without dropping the resupply bundles.

3. Radio communication was satisfactory throughout.

4. There were scattered thunderstorms in the Adriatic and northern Albanian but the weather was clear with good visibility along the flight path. The winds were substantially as forecast.

5. No enemy action was encountered.

6. The resupply mission was laid on again for the following night.

1. The following is a report of the second attempt at resupply for the Apple Tree Team. It was originally scheduled for September 5-6 but was aborted due to failure to locate the DZ. Leaflets were again dropped for cover purposes.

The total flight time was six hours and fifteen minutes, including one hour and twenty-one minutes over Albania. Twelve minutes were spent over DZ #3 as BGFriend personnel felt there was a possibility that Apple Tree Team might have sent in the wrong HTRegale grid numbers. However, the DZ was located at DZ #4, the same area which the crew reported having

having searched the previous night.

3. Ten cases of "Symbol" leaflets, six gummed and four ungummed, weighing 1100 pounds, were dropped, one each at DZs 1 and 2, and four each at Elbasan and Lushnje. The uneven distribution was occasioned by the fact the crew were instructed to return with five cases if they were unable to locate the DZ. The same resupply load, consisting of four bundles, was dropped at DZ #4.

4. Radio communication was satisfactory until the time for frequency change. When the W/T operator made the change he lost contact with the base and reverted to the former frequency. Contact was reestablished but faded out after the resupply drop and the remainder of the trip was completed in radio silence.

5. The weather was clear with good visibility over Albania.

6. No enemy action was encountered.
