1. The five man Willow Team was dispatched to Northern Greece on 2 July and is expected to infiltrate o/a 4 July. Present plans call for Willow to establish contact with their former friends and continue to service the dead-letter drops.

2. Composition:

Willow Team composition remains unchanged.

3. Mission:

Willow Team's mission is generally the same as reported in 1630-CAGWU and SGAA-907.

4. Training:

Willow Team's training consisted of physical conditioning - including hiking, map and compass work, first aid, weapons and agent training.

5. Briefing:

The briefing for Willow Team was altered and amended to include the following:

a. Gather all available information regarding teams in your general area of operation. (This was done in hopes of gaining some information regarding Apple/2's exfiltration attempt).

b. Make every attempt to bring out at least 2 bills of each denomination of "Lek."

c. Continue to acquire information on military units, regarding commanders, strength, location, disposition, equipment and organization.

d. Report any changes in party organization - what possibilities exist for defection.

- e. Review security of your operation, and loyalty of your friends and contacts.
- f. What changes, if any, have been made in documents. Attempt to bring out I.D., Front Card, Soldiers Book and any other documents that are required for travel within the country. Attempt to determine reasons for use of various colors on covers of the Soldiers Book.
- g. Turn over new broadcast schedule for committee radio to friends and determine effectiveness of the radio on the population.
- h. What information is available regarding Soviet and Satellite military and civilian advisors - have there been any changes or replacements.
- i. Attempt to locate safe area for establishing W/T base.

The above points were stressed, however, all items covered in past briefings were also included.

6. Duration:

Willow is expected to return to base o/a 1 August. This date may vary, however, depending upon what remains of Willow's previous contacts and net.

7. Remarks:

- a. Willow showed an extremely high degree of morale, interest and willingness throughout the short period they were in training.
- b. The number of times that Willow will be infiltrated this operational season will be determined after a complete debriefing of their present operation.
