Up to the receipt of the subject reference neither Dr. GERBER-ROEDER nor any of his local activities had come to the attention of file checks proved negative.</p> <p>2. The Subject's name was then raised with [] [] is personally acquainted with Dr. ROEDER and furnished us the following information on him:</p> <p>a. Dr. Rudolf GERBER-ROEDER arrived in Indonesia in about mid 1960. He claims to be a free-lance journalist representing several West German news media and specifically the <u>SUD DEUTSCHE ZEITUNG</u>. The Subject had told BESHINE that in addition to news reporting he is currently gathering information on Indonesia as he plans to write a book on this country. <u>OF INTEREST TO WESTERN INTELL.</u></p> <p>b. The Subject is about forty years old. He is commonly known as Dr. ROEDER. The Subject married just prior to coming to Indonesia. His wife is a Doctor of Medicine and is in her late thirties. She is presently with him in Indonesia. [] had the Subject's calling card and address, but could not locate it at the time of our visit. However, [] stated that the ROEDERS live with the widow of a former West German Embassy official who died here and who's wife remained in Indonesia and who presently works with the West German Information Center located on Djalan Segara I, Djakarta.</p> <p>c. Subject was a very close friend of Mr. Leopoldus, the former West German Commercial Counsellor to Indonesia.</p> <p>d. Presently Subject is very close socially to Mr. Carl Weiss, 2nd Secretary and Information Officer of the West German Embassy in <u>Indonesia</u>.</p> <p>e. [] states that the Subject and his wife are very pleasant people and that the Subject appears to be very well informed on the current events in Indonesia.</p> <p>3. As stated in our FMDT 1791, 20 October 1961, Mr. Carl Weiss is suspected of having some intelligence functions. A copy of the FMDT 1791 is hereby attached for the information of the Chief, Liaison Base, Munich and the Chief of Station, Germany.</p>
