<p>1. Subject is of course not unknown to this Base. Our records on him go back to the early days of CATUSK when an investigation of his past revealed the fact pretty much described in Reference without, however, the possible criminal implications. His intelligence connections were also of less than sterling nature. As early as 1953 this Base recommended that he be fired. Apparently all that CATUSK saw fit to do was to change him from fulltime employment as a staffer to part-time employment as an outside man, under unofficial cover.</p> <p>2. We trust, however, that addressees are aware that men of Subject's ilk are few and far between at CATUSK and that even the few are being constantly reduced to fewer as time goes on, and men with less association with the Nazi area become available to CATUSK.</p>
