Please forward traces on WRABEL

1. During a recent meeting with UPHILL's GRENHARDT, he noted that UPHILL had contacted various references cited in the PEE of

Dr. Emeric OFCZANEK
(Alias SCHRITTER, an UPHILL staff officer),

and that among them was one

(Reg. Rat) Robert WRABEL
 INFO: unknown ~~Supposed to be a contact of Dr. Emeric~~
 Resides Vienna III, Nonnweg 93. **OFCZANEK**

GRENHARDT then read to us a letter he had received from WRABEL describing OFCZANEK's role in the 20 July 1944 plot to exterminate Hitler. At the time both WRABEL and OFCZANEK were serving together and both were aware of the plot, according to WRABEL's letter. OFCZANEK had in his possession a letter mentioning various plans which implicated WRABEL, and had OFCZANEK not destroyed this, WRABEL undoubtedly would have been executed. The letter was written with considerable sincerity, and GRENHARDT does not feel that it was something "cooked up" between WRABEL and OFCZANEK. GRENHARDT was particularly pleased to receive this since OFCZANEK had served with the SS during the war, and there had been some question as to how fanatical a Nazi he had been.

2. Nevertheless, GRENHARDT is not so naive as to accept the statement completely at face value, and would appreciate our checking KUBARK files for any derogatory information on WRABEL.

3. Munich files note that WRABEL is mentioned in the attachment to MGLA-1073 which summarizes the activities of Richard KAUDER-KIATT in the period 1945 to November 1949. KAUDER visited the former Major WRABEL, who was one of the owners of the Firms GOSTINSCHENCOG. UPHILL files identified WRABEL as Robert Otto WRABEL who was with the Austrian Gendarmerie under FSY
