1. The Continental Affairs Research Institute (Tairiku Mondai Kenkyu Sho) issued its first periodical publication, an 80 page pamphlet entitled Continent (Tairiku) on 30 January 1952....				
2. An evaluation of the contents of the magazine (see att. A) given by one of the members of the Institute who is well acquainted with but not closely allied to DOI Akio, the president, is that there is no information which any person familiar with international affairs could not present without any particular research. In detail, the member made the following comments:				
a. The list of persons sending congratulatory messages includes a number of persons known to be associated with DOI. Those whose relationship to him is less definitely understood are AMABA (AMOO) Eiji; <u>OGATA Taketora</u> , formerly president of the Cabinet Information Bureau, Cabinet Secretary General, and editor in chief of the Asahi Shimbun....
