PERTINENT INFORMATION Excerpted verbatim from desk dossier - FE/1/Japan May 20 - Taketora OGATA, Premier YOSHIDA's personal envoy, on 16 May left Hong Kong by air for Bangkok after a 3-day visit to the British colony. <u>OGATA</u> had travelled to Hong Kong via Taipei. The Japanese envoy said that his talks with British officials and businessmen of HK had been "of great help", and that such subjects as Japanese trade with Hong Kong and Communist China, the Korean issue, and Communist activities in SEA had been discussed.
