PERTINENT INFORMATION Excerpted verbatim from desk dossier - FE/1/Japan  May 27 - Indonesian diplomatic circles in Tokyo stated on 26 May that <u>Taketora OGATA</u> will probably receive a cold reception in Jakarta because he went to Taipei to talk with Chinese Nationalist leaders. Indonesian diplomats pointed out that Indonesia has recognised MAO Tse-tung's regime and will not deal in intimate terms with leaders friendly to the Nationalist Government.
