A quarrel in which General HO (HO Shih-li) opposes CHANG Po-chin, chief of the Second Section of the Chinese Mission; SUNG Yueh-lun, public relations officer of the mission; and YUAN Wei-hsin, former chief of the missions's General Affairs Section. CHANG, SUNG, and YUAN have accused HO of illegally withholding their pay. SUNG incurred General HO's displeasure when he accompanied <u>OGATA Taketora</u>, Premier YOSHIDA's envoy, from Taiwan to Hong Kong without consulting HO. SUNG's original assignment was to go to Taiwan only.<sup>3</sup> SUNG claims, however, that he was ordered to Hong Kong by CHIANG Kai-shek to see that OGATA was not surrounded by Third Force supporters.....</p>				
<p>3 <u>Source Comment.</u> Ho attempted to impress OGATA before he left for Taiwan, because he still hopes to become China's first post-war ambassador to Japan, and sent SUNG to Taiwan to help make arrangements for OGATA's visit there.</p>
