PERTINENT INFORMATION Excerpted verbatim from desk dossier - FE/1/Japan. Aug 7 - Gen. CHANG Ch'un, Gimo's envoy, assured YOSHIDA of the Chinese Nationalists' full support and cooperation in carrying out the Japanese program for trade and the economic tie-up with SEA countries. CHANG also suggested the establishment of a Chinese-Japanese joint corporation for SEA trade, as well as the investment of Japan's surplus sterling holdings in the Chinese overseas market in the southern seas. During a 3-hr conversation, CHANG said he "exchanged views with YOSHIDA over a wide range of subjects, both political and economic".
