THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION IS EXCERPTED VERBATIM				
1. CHANG Ch'un's (1728/5028) visit to Japan during the summer and early autumn of 1952 was occasioned by what <u>OGATA Taketora</u> (4872/2455/4554/5706), now State Minister, had told CHANG and CHIANG Kai-shek when OGATA visited Taiwan. <sup>2</sup> Since his arrival in Japan, CHANG has been disappointed to find conditions were not as OGATA had described them. <sup>3</sup> He is, however, staying in Japan in order to resume negotiations with the Japanese government.				
2 <u>Field Comment</u> . OGATA visited Taiwan during May 1952 as Prime Minister YOSHIDA's special envoy.
