<u>Comment:</u> FUKUNAGA's election campaign has been under close scrutiny for several weeks; in all, more than 40 persons have been arrested on charges of violating election laws in connection with his campaign. Earlier, following the suicide of a local assemblyman charged with involvement in the case, FUKUNAGA expressed his desire to resign his Cabinet post and devote full time to checking the alleged election law violations. At that time, Deputy Prime Minister <u>OGATA</u> advised FUKUNAGA to remain in his job.
