Disturbed by the furor created by his Diet remarks on the defense problem last Tuesday, Finance Minister OKAZAKI tried to set the record straight. At an emergency meeting of Lower House Liberals, he asserted that the government's views on war potential and the Constitution have "undergone no change since the signing of the security pact in 1951."....			
Deputy Prime Minister <u>OGATA</u> joined the government effort to define "war potential". He said: "Even atomic bombs and jet planes would not constitute war potential if Japan does not use them to settle international disputes."
