PERTINENT INFORMATION The following information is excerpted verbatim from FE/1/dossier. <i>Japan</i> The embassy comments that within the Liberal Party, second-rank leadership has shifted from party policy-maker IKEDA (Hayato) to Deputy Prime Minister <u>OGATA Taketora</u> , who, in addition to being unsullied by the investigations, is reported to have established a working relationship with KISHI Sinsuke, an influential political figure. Although OGATA and KISHI apparently would have good prospects for organizing a coalition, OGATA's loyalty to YOSHIDA is still unquestionable.
