2. HOSHINA (Zenshiro) and KIMURA (Tokutaro) desire to set up an <u>OGATA</u> Cabinet with the deputy premier from the Progressive Party. Justice Minister INUKAI Takeru would be dropped from the Cabinet. ³ The new Cabinet would push through essential legislation, such as the new status for the National Safety Force.

3. According to <u>Jiji</u> , INUKAI Takeru tendered his resignation on 21 April 1954 through Deputy Premier OGATA, after having issued an order instructing the procurator-general to postpone the arrest of Liberal Party Secretary-General SATO Eisaku.
