<p>THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION IS EXCERPTED VERBATIM</p> <p>POLITICAL REPORT</p> <p>1. <u>Current Developments:</u></p> <p>a. <u>Government Pushes Legislation:</u> With the nonconfidence motion out of the way, the Administration announced plans to push for rapid enactment of legislation now before the Diet. Plans call for an Upper House vote on the MDA Agreement on 28 Apr (the Lower House has already approved) and quick action on other defense-related measures.
