SUBJECT: OHLBRUECK, (Fnu)
Alleged Agent of Gehlen Organization

20 September 1960

1. OHLBRUECK, a German National, is presently residing in KHARTOUM, Sudan where he is employed as a Kaufman (Merchant). Source reports that this is merely a cover, that OHLBRUECK is actually serving as an agent of the West German Gehlen Organization. As such, he is "unofficially" subordinate to the West German Ambassador in the Sudan, Dr. HAAS.
2. During WWII, OHLBRUECK was allegedly a member of the SS and active in the German intelligence service. He is described as an extremely clever individual who has made many friends among the Sudanese.
3. During 1952 - 1953, OHLBRUECK was active in Egypt. He approached several members of the unofficial German military advisory group in Egypt at that time to supply him with certain information on Egyptian military forces. Those approached were led to believe that OHLBRUECK was working on behalf of the US Department of State or a US intelligence agency at that time.
4. OHLBRUECK's daughter was married to a wealthy Egyptian Copt in the not too distant past.
