11. 1939 - Col., 1940 appointed Mil. Att. Stockholm, Sweden; 1943 - Maj Gen.
12. 1945 - Left Naples for repatriation on SS FLUS ULTRA.
13. May-Jul 46 @ Interrogated at Sugamo Prison by SSU/CFR.
14. 1952 - Associated with SIB until it was terminated in advisory capacity & taken over by PSIA. Employed as advisor by Tokyo Ge-run-mu K.I., Swedish firm located at 3, 2-choms, Nishi-Ginza, Chuo-ku.
15. Mar 1952 - Reported by Zenei as member of KATO Intel org. Reportedly attended several meetings of Continental Affairs Research Institute.

1. 1952 - addressed Ural Kai on "European Situation as Seen from Sweden" on 4 July 1952.
2. 1953 (Feb) - Took trip to Sweden for private reasons, principally to recover bank account & other properties he left in Sweden at end of war when recalled to Tokyo. No Jap. govt agency requested him to engage in intel activities; trip gave rise to unfavorable publicity in Swedish newspaper which embarrassed Japanese consulate in Stockholm.
