A. REFERENCE YOUR W 92706 (WASH 1439). ONODERA AND ONOUCHI
HAVE GIVEN FOLLOWING INFORMATION CONCERNING COLLABORATION
OF THE JAPANESE AND POLISH INTELLIGENCE SERVICES.

PARA 1. COOPERATION DATES BACK TO RUSSO-JAPANESE WAR, AND
WAS BEGUN BY GENERALS PILSUDSKI AND AKASHI.

PARA 2. THE FOLLOWING JAPANESE INTELLIGENCE SERVICES
OFFICES STUDIED CRYPTO-ANALYSIS WITH POLISH INTELLIGENCE
SERVICE IN WARSAW SINCE EARLY 1920'S THROUGH ARRANGEMENT
BETWEEN JAPANESE AND POLISH GENERAL STAFFS. (COLONEL SEIKICHI
HIYAKUTAKE, GENERAL SHUNJIRO OKUBO, COLONEL KUDO, COLONEL
EIICHI FUKAI, COLONEL NOBUTA SAKURAI (FAMILY NAMES ARE SHOWN
LAST)).

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PARA 3. POLISH INTELLIGENCE SERVICE ALSO INSTRUCTED
JAPANESE INTELLIGENCE SERVICE IN DOCUMENT ANALYSIS. (COLONEL
KOWALEWSKI (WAR TIME POLISH MILITARY ATTACHE, LONDON) VISITED
TOKYO FOR THIS PURPOSE. CONSUL KUYATKOWSKI AND CONSUL RYBICKI
(JAPANESE SPELLINGS) AND POSSIBLY COLONEL [redacted] INSTRUCTED
KWANTUNG ARMY INTELLIGENCE SERVICE IN [redacted]

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PARA 4. AFTER THE DEFEAT OF POLAND, COLONEL GANO PROPOSED TO COLONEL UEDA, JAPANESE MILITARY ATTACHE, WARSAW THAT JAPANESE INTELLIGENCE SERVICE TAKE OVER POLISH ESPIONAGE SYSTEM AGAINST UNION OF SOVIET SOCIALIST REPUBLICS AND GERMANY. THIS WAS REFUSED BY TOKYO.

PARA 5. IN 1940 GANO SENT A POLISH INTELLIGENCE SERVICE MISSION TO TOKYO FOR COOPERATION WITH JAPANESE INTELLIGENCE SERVICE. ALL MEMBERS OF THIS RETURNED TO EUROPE IN 1942 WITH COLONEL KREVEDY, POLISH MILITARY ATTACHE, TOKYO, EXCEPT TWO. ONE OF THESE WAS LIEUTENANT SKORSKI LAST HEARD OF IN MANCHURIA. REQUEST FOR PERMISSION FOR HIM TO REMAIN WITH JAPANESE INTELLIGENCE SERVICE AND AFFIRMATIVE ANSWER FROM KIKORSKY LONDON WERE HANDLED THROUGH ONODERA'S OFFICE IN STOCKHOLM.

6. MICHAL RUBIKOWSKI ALIAS PRITREK WIANON ALIAS MICHAEL WOIWSKI ALIAS RIBICKI WORKED WITH SHIMURA IN STOCKHOLM, AND XONOUCHI IN RIGA 1940, AND WITH ONODERA IN STOCKHOLM 1941-1944. HE WAS IN TOUCH WITH THE FOLLOWING POLISH AGENTS: JACUBIC ALIAS KUNCZEWIECZ AND LAPINSKA IN BERLIN; PERZ AND WADZUS (WITH SUGIHARA) IN KAUNAS AND KOENIGSBERG; POLISHKIETICZ AND TOMAS IN WARSAW; BURKA IN VIENNA; KRUBKIEWIECZ AND WJESOWITOW IN RIGA; PASZARA (DABA) IN HELSINKI; WYKOVALEWSKI IN PORTUGAL. INFORMATION FROM THESE SOURCES WAS TRANSMITTED THROUGH JAPANESE AND MANCHURIAN MISSIONS IN BERLIN AND ONODERA'S OFFICE IN STOCKHOLM TO LONDON.

7. RUBIKOWSKI ALSO HAD A SOURCE BELIEVED TO BE THE FORMER POLISH MINISTER, HELSINKI, IN THE POLISH MISSION TO MOSCOW. HIS REPORTS WERE RELAYED THROUGH LONDON TO RUBIKOWSKI-ONODERA IN STOCKHOLM.

8. RUBIKOWSKI WAS EXPELLED BY THE SWEDISH GOVERNMENT IN SPRING 1944. HE WENT TO LONDON AND THEN JOINED GENERAL ANDERS ARMY IN ITALY. AFTER HIS DEPARTURE ONODERA MAINTAINED CONTACT WITH BRZESKINSKI, POLISH MILITARY ATTACHE, STOCKHOLM THROUGH WHOM HE RECEIVED FOLLOWING INTELLIGENCE FROM GANO AND RUBIKOWSKI:

A. WARNING OF UNION OF SOVIET SOCIALIST REPUBLICS ENTRANCE INTO WAR AGAINST JAPAN.

B. MOVEMENT OF RUSSIAN TROOPS TO FAR EASTERN FRONT. AFTER JAPANESE SURRENDER GANO OFFERED MONEY AND PROTECTION

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IF ONODERA WAS NOT IN ACCORD WITH PRESENT JAPANESE GOVERNMENT.

9. BEFORE LEAVING SWEDEN RUBIKOWSKI ARRANGED FOR ONODERA TO RECEIVE INTELLIGENCE ON WESTERN ALLIES FROM STEPHAN *GADOMSKI THROUGH *RZADA AND "LISTER BERG" IN STOCKHOLM. ONODERA PAID \$10,000 FOR THESE REPORTS BUT BELIEVES THEM TO HAVE BEEN BRITISH DECEPTION MATERIAL.

10. COLONEL LOS, POLISH MILITARY ATTACHE, HELSINKI, WAS KNOWN TO ONOUCHI BUT THEY DID NOT COLLABORATE. LOS MOVED TO STOCKHOLM WHERE HE REMAINED WORKING FOR POLISH INTELLIGENCE SERVICE AGAINST GERMANY.

11. ONODERA AND ONOUCHI HAVE PROVIDED A LIST OF JAPANESE INTELLIGENCE SERVICE SPECIALISTS ON POLAND AND RUSSIA FOR FURTHER INTERROGATION.

B 1. THE FOLLOWING REPORTS ARE NOW COMPLETED: ONODERA, ONOUCHI, HIROSE, ITO, KIKOSHI, TATSUYA SATO, INOUE, KICHINSUKE SATO.

2. AT THE REQUEST OF THIS HEADQUARTERS I AM LEAVING PHOTOSTAT CARD FILE AND RELATED DOCUMENTS WITH THE ASSISTANT CHIEF OF STAFF, G-2, AND AM BRIEFING OFFICER FOR FURTHER INTERROGATIONS OF WHICH STRATEGIC SERVICE UNIT, CENTRAL INTELLIGENCE GROUP WILL RECEIVE COPIES.

3. I PLAN TO DEPART FOR WASHINGTON ON ABOUT JULY 31.
