SUBJECT: Interrogation of General Makoto Onodera *copy filed in C*

REFERENCE: *C-7* #487 (IN 15178)

1. Subject interrogation was effected by Lt. Cmdr. Theodore Rousseau of the Strategic Services Unit at the Sugamo Prison in Tokyo between 6 May and 20 July 1946. It is presumed that the interrogator, who worked under the auspices of General MacArthur's G-2 had submitted a copy of the subject interrogation report to G-2 in Tokyo.
2. It would be appreciated if you were to inquire whether or not all or part of the subject interrogation report was given to the British authorities either in the field or through G-2 in Washington.
