Education: 1912-1915 Local cadet school in Sendai (German Section)  
 1915-1917 Central Cadet School, Tokyo  
 1917-1919 Military Academy (Infantry Course), Tokyo  
 1919 Commissioned 2nd Lt. attached to 29th Infantry Regiment, Sendai  
 1920 Graduated from Military Academy where he learned Russian  
 1922 Promoted to 1st Lt., Infantry  
 1925 Matriculated at War College, Aoyama  
 1925 Appointed instructor in Preparatory Military Academy  
 1927 Married ICHIBONE Yukiko  
 1928 Promoted to Captain. Graduated from War College. Served as company commander in 29th Infantry Regt., Sendai, later moved to Aizu Wakamatsu

1930-1932 Superintendent and instructor in experimental section of Army Infantry School, Chiba  
 1931-1933 Army General Staff Hq. Dept II, Russian Section of European-American Division  
 1933-1934 Resident in North Manchuria. Lived in Harbin and studied Russian for future service in Europe  
 1934-1935 Member of General Staff Hq., attached to Dept. II, China Section. Duties concerned only with USSR  
 1935-1938 Military Attache, Riga, Latvia  
 Jun-Oct 1935 - Member of General Staff, Dept. II, Russian Section; Instructor in Military Science at Army General Staff College, Tokyo  
 At this time, one of associates was Maj. KOTANI Etsuo  
 Oct-Jun 1938-1939 - Attached to Operations Section of Expeditionary Force in China. Political Mission. Intelligence concerning China's Communist and Nationalist movements, with particular emphasis on C.C. group  
 1939 Promoted to Colonel  
 1940 Appointed Military Attache, Stockholm, Sweden  
 Stopped over on way to see Military Attache to Finland, Col. ONOUCHI Hideo/  
 1942 (Sept.) - Promoted to Major General

Jan 1946 Left Naples for repatriation on SS PLUS ULTRA  
 May-July 1946 - Interrogated at Sugamo Prison by SSU/CIG  
 1952 - Associated with SI 8 until it was terminated in advisory capacity  
 and taken over by PSIA  
 Employed as advisor by Tokyo Ge-ru-su K. I. Swedish firm located  
 at 3,2-chome, Mishi-Ginza, Chuo-Ku.  
 1952 (Mar.) - Reported by Zenel as member of KATO Intelligence organization. b150a/  
 Reportedly attended several meetings of Continental Affairs Research  
 Institute b150a/

1952 Addressed Ural Kai or "European Situation as Seen from Sweden" on 4 July  
b151/

1953 (Feb) Took trip to Sweden for private reasons, principally to recover  
 bank account and other properties he left in Sweden at end of war  
 then recalled to Tokyo. No Jap. govt agency requested him to  
 engage in intel. activities; trip gave rise to unfavorable publicity  
 in Swedish newspaper which embarrassed Japanese consulate in  
 Stockholm. b152/
