Reference is made to your letter dated November 25, 1958, reporting contact with Soviet official at the United Nations by subject and Ivan Koshelivets, your reference CS CI-3/752, 356.

In view of the fact that subject entered the United States under your control on January 11, 1952, and is presently employed at Prolog Research and Publishing Association, Inc., New York City, which association is of interest to you, you are requested to furnish any additional pertinent background information concerning him and advise us if you would have any objection to our contacting him.

In reply to referenced letter, we have received no information concerning contact made by subject with Soviet United Nations officials. A source has advised that subject wrote a critical review of a book entitled "Immigrants in the US" by L. A. Bagramov.

The above information from our source should not be disseminated without prior reference to this Bureau.
