LAHORE, OCT. 26 (APA) -- THE JAT-PAT TORAK MANDAL (CASTE-BREAKING ORGANIZATION) OF LAHORE FRIDAY ASKED THE HINDUS "TO RETAKE THE FORCIBLY CONVERTED MEN (IN EAST BENGAL) BACK INTO THEIR SOCIETY WITHOUT ANY EXPLANATION."

THE MANDAL IN A RESOLUTION "CONDEMNED THE ORGY, CARNAGE AND FORCIBLE CONVERSIONS PERPETRATED BY MISGUIDED PEOPLE" IN THAT TROUBLED PART OF INDIA AND CITED BEFORE HINDUS THE EXAMPLE OF THE BRITISH PEOPLE "WHO HAVE TAKEN BACK INTO SOCIETY WAR BABIES AND THEIR MOTHERS.

"ACCORDING TO THE SHASTRAS," THE MANDAL ADDED, "A FORCIBLY ABDUCTED AND IMPREGNATED WOMAN IS AS PURE AS A VIRGIN WHEN SHE MENSTRUATES FROM THE FIRST TIME AFTER DELIVERY."

FINALLY, RESOLUTION SUGGESTED "THE TRUE AND PERMANENT REMEDY FOR ALL SUCH COMMUNAL DISTURBANCES IS TO ABOLISH CASTE ROOT AND BRANCH, IN THE PRESENCE OF WHICH THERE COULD NEVER BE PEACE AND FREEDOM IN INDIA." A. P. OF AMERICA.
