SUBJECT: Postal Intercept

1. The following postal intercept (U.S. Civil Censorship Submission, Civil Censorship Division, USFET) dated 3 January 1947 from Heins JUERGES - *Jurges* Berlin-Reinickendorf-West, Berlinerstr. 84 II, bei Renner to Senor Ernesto QUENTHER - *Quenther* Thames 2404, Buenos Aires, Rep. Argentina is forwarded to you for your information:

"POSSIBLE HENCHMAN OF MARTIN BORMANN AT PRESENT IN LIECHTENSTEIN

" ... Today I read a notice in the paper which sounded very improbable to me .... According to this Fritz MANDL (665 A-3) is residing in Europe, in Liechtenstein, quite near to the Austrian border.

"If that should be true, he certainly must have some big illegal deal in mind. Otherwise he never would have dared to leave Argentina. Is it possible that his special friend, Martin BORMANN sent him to Europe in order to transfer some remaining riches illegally over there? MANDL has considerable practice in that ...

".... As I can see from your letter, my departure from Montevideo has been strongly commented on .... Do you remember what I wrote you as late as half a year ago from Montevideo? ... "

2. The letter was written in German.
