1. In an interview with Mr. Walther Heissig, the German SS Mongolia expert, it was learned that a certain Captain Maston of R&A had interview Heissig some months ago and had collected maps from him. It is believed by this office that these maps might be of value and it is requested that any maps regarding Inner and Outer Mongolia from this source be sent to this headquarters.

2. Heissig as an employee of the German Intelligence Service undoubtedly submitted to his German headquarters, documents of a confidential nature concerning the Mongolian political picture. It is requested that Washington, if possible, make inquiries to the Occupational Forces in Berlin to discover the location of these documents.

3. If these documents are found, it is requested that the pertinent information be forwarded to this headquarters.
