1. CARRIAGE INDICATES MURDER NOT COMMITTED BY SUBJECT, ALSO INDICATES HIS STATEMENT TRUE THAT HE SUBSEQUENTLY RECEIVED POSTCARD FROM HER FROM MOSCOW. GENERAL LOCAL OPINION HE WAS FRAMED BY COMMIES ON COURT MARTIAL. WAS LATER REINSTATED FULL RANK AND PRIVILEGES.
