SUBJECT : Edvins OZOLINS

1. It is requested that approval be granted to bring subject individual to the U.S. "black" by means of an   flight. This approval must be received prior to 25 September 1954.

2. Subject is a contract agent of this Agency and has been granted a full Operational Clearance dated 5 November 1951 (no number assigned). An appropriately amended clearance for subject has been requested for the purpose of debriefing him in the U.S. for an extended period, approximating six months, subsequent to which, should it be determined that he desires to remain in the U.S., steps will be initiated in order to effect his legal immigration under Section 8 of Public Law 110 and help him resettle in the U.S. In the event it is deemed advisable or necessary, he may be returned to Germany "black" and remain there pending the outcome of the initiated action under P.L. 110. If, on the basis of a thorough technical interview or his personal preference, it is considered more appropriate to resettle him in an area other than the U.S., the proper action will be initiated at that time. Should an attempt of resettlement elsewhere become involved and entail a great deal of time, he may be flown to Germany to await the final resettlement solution.

3. Inasmuch as he will initially be brought to the U.S. on the basis of a temporary stay, it is requested that the requirement for a technical interview prior to entry into the U.S. be waived. Since there has been no direct contact with subject since 1952, it is considered inappropriate for the case officer to attempt an assessment of subject inasmuch as it is most probable that the man's character has undergone major changes, and the 1952 assessment would no longer reflect the true nature of his character, outlook on life, etc.

4. Due to the fact that this agent is currently involved in a most sensitive operation he must be evacuated from Europe and brought to the U.S. for debriefing by qualified Headquarters personnel as rapidly as possible. Consequently, your cooperation and support is urgently requested and will be greatly appreciated.
