SUBJECT : Edvins OZOLINS

1. Subject has recently been involved in a most sensitive operation in a denied area. This Branch is presently implementing steps for his removal from Europe - to take place during March 1955. Since it is most necessary to bring him to the United States as rapidly as possible in order to minimize any possibility of movement traces, it is requested that approval be granted to bring subject into the U.S. "black" by means of an [] flight.

2. Subject is a contract agent of this Agency who was granted a full Operational Clearance (no number assigned) dated 5 November 1951. A covert security clearance AJO 5397 dated 28 September 1954 was granted for the purpose of bringing subject to the U.S. for extensive debriefings by Headquarters' personnel. A request has been submitted for the renewal of this clearance.

3. Inasmuch as he will initially be brought to the U.S. on the basis of a temporary stay, it is also requested that the requirements for a technical interview prior to entry into the U.S. be waived.

4. Subsequent to the debriefings, action on his resettlement will be initiated. However, his entry into the U.S. and his placement in a secure area is our primary objective. Your expeditious handling of this request is urgently requested and will be greatly appreciated.
