At the end of Pulawska Street in Warsaw, Poland, a new office building for the KBI (Internal Security Corps) and the MBP (Ministry of State Security) has been built. It is reported to be a very large building with four floors above ground and two below. The two subterranean floors are made up of small prison cells. While it was being erected, the structure was called "Building Ksawerus".
