1. During a visit to Frankfurt am Main in September 1947, [ ] visited HAAS-HEYE to inform him that the publication of his manuscript would be held up for an indefinite period. [ ] felt that because of the tense international situation, publication of his material would antagonize all Germany's occupying powers.

2. HAAS-HEYE informed [ ] that he had recently seen LENTZ, formerly of the German Intercept Service. LENTZ had talked with WEISENBORN, from whom he had learned that the Russians had approached WEISENBORN and asked him to keep in touch with his former German EQUAL contacts.

Field Comment : LENTZ is apparently Waldemar Otto Hermann Walther LENTZ, who was attached to OKW/IN/7/VI/12, with Sonderkommando PANWITZ. Complete information on him may be found in the interrogation report on him and KURFESS, CSDIC/CMF/SD 80, 11 October 1945. ( i.e. XX-9761).
